

RIs:

At first glance, "course following" appears to be nothing more then doing the route instructions (RIs), but actually it means something very different. "Course following" refers to the turns and path you take between doing the RIs. Usually, these are the instructions in the Order of Precedence (O of P) that are lower then the RIs (typically, the T-Rule (R or L at uninstructed T intersection), Straight as Possible (SAP), and U). Occasisionally, other rules will be used for course following such as turn or remain on a particular named road or one with the more dominant striping (Follow Lined Road).

Rallyes that use course following gimmicks often require the RIs to be "course directing." That is, the RI must take you in a direction different then you would have otherwise gone. The RIs cannot be executed if they are "redundant" with the path determined by the course following rules. Consequently, rallyes can be written with less RIs and a few more gimmicks.

Exercise #3: K, do RI 1 over Follow Lined Road, do RI 2 at Raider, Y (L on Charger), do RI 3 at Q, N (Follow Lined Road), do RI 4 at Seahawk (Follow Lined Road had priority over R at T so the RI was not redundant), M, V.
