

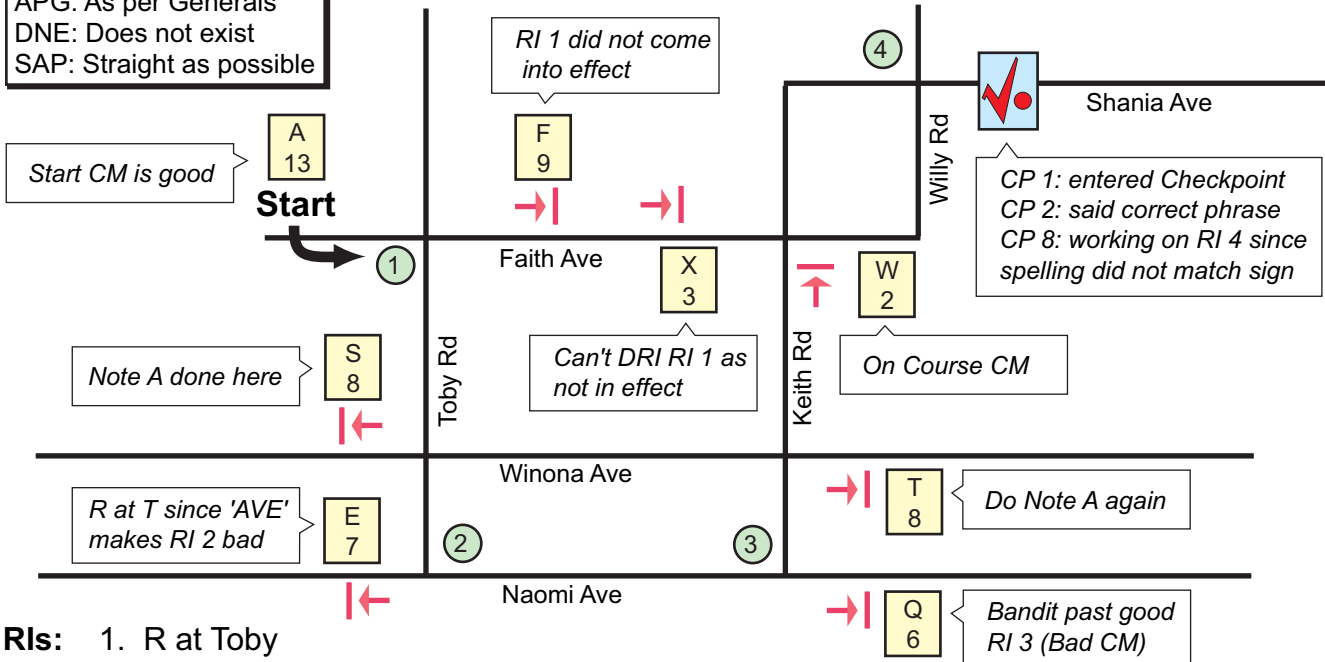
Keep a Run Sheet

SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

Although it is not required, experienced contestants keep a Run Sheet. A run sheet is a log of how you ran the rallye. At the Finish, you can compare your run sheet to the critique (rallye's answer sheet) to see how you did. To do a run sheet, just record the RI in effect, the coursemarker, its location and the reason you found it. Without a run sheet or some other record of the coursemarkers you saw, it's difficult to know the ones you missed.

Rallye Abbrevs:
APG: As per Generals
DNE: Does not exist
SAP: Straight as possible

Hint: Beware of Scoresheet gimmicks. When using a run sheet, it's easy to ignore the Scoresheet and miss double or missing spaces.



Hint: Develop a system that works for you. Use abbreviations to save time and be sure you can read what you have written. Arguing for points because of a run sheet error is embarrassing.
